Shared Service Agreement Between Point Pleasant Board of Education and Bay Head Board of Education for Technology Services

Preliminary discussions took place with Dr. Morris, Superintendent of the Bay Head School District, Kevin McDermitt, Supervisor of Technology, Mr. Corso, and Superintendent Smith, to discuss the possibility of a Shared Services Agreement for technology services between the two districts. Mr. McDermitt visited Bay Head to evaluate their needs and felt with our current technology personnel, we would be able to meet Bay Head's needs. Bay Head would be willing to pay \$25,000 for our services for the 2018-2019 school year. A draft agreement will be provided to our board attorney for review.

Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights School District and School Grades

Schools are required to complete a self-assessment to determine grades under the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act. The self-assessment includes: HIB programs and initiatives, training provided to staff and students, curriculum/instruction, and reporting and investigation procedures. The maximum grade that can be achieved is 78. Ms. Miller provided the following grades: High School – 76, Memorial Middle School – 76, Nellie F. Bennett Elementary School – 78, Ocean Road Elementary School – 77, overall district grade – 77.
